

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF TELKWA

BYLAW NO. 412, 1997

A bylaw to amend "The Corporation of the Village of Telkwa Business Licence Bylaw No. 176, 1982" and repeal "The Corporation of the Village of Telkwa Business License Fee Amendment Bylaw No. 386, 1996.

The Council of the Corporation of the Village of Telkwa, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1.0 "The Corporation of the Village of Telkwa Business License Fee Amendment Bylaw No. 386, 1996 is hereby repealed and Schedules I and II, Section 2.8, and Division VI of "The Corporation of the Village of Telkwa Business Licence Bylaw No. 176, 1982, and is hereby replaced with the following Schedules I and II, Section 2.8, and Division VI.
- 2.8 Except as hereinafter provided, a licence will be granted for a one year period, commencing the first day of January and terminating on the 31st day of December. Except for a seasonal business for which fees shall be reduced by fifty (50%), no proportionate reduction shall be made on account for any person commencing or ceasing to do business at any particular time. A seasonal business is one that operates for less than 180 days in a year. No licence fee paid hereunder shall be refunded in whole or in part.

Division VI

The business classification set out in this Division are deemed to be separate and distinct businesses. A separate licence is required for each classification. A person eligible for more than one business licence shall, for each licence in excess of the principal licence, receive a reduction in licence fees as listed below. The principal licence is the licence for which the greatest fee is due.

Schedule II

Fees

Persons making application for a licence not specifically mentioned in Schedule I, shall pay the following fees.

- 1.0 Other \$ 60.00/year

- 2.0 This Bylaw may be cited as "Business License Fees Amendment Bylaw No. 412, 1997" and shall come into effect upon the registration thereof in the office of the Inspector of Municipalities.

- 2.1 For the billing period January 1 - December 31, 1997, accounts which have paid the January 1-April 15, 1997 licence fees will receive a reduction of 30 % in the fees outlined in Schedule I and II.
